All entries **must be original paintings belonging to the artist (no photography)**. Hanging art must be in gallery ready framing and wired for hanging. Gallery Wrap canvas is accepted. 3-D art is accepted.

Maximum dimensions 7" x 9" including frame. 3D art not to exceed 8" in any direction including base.

All entries must be for sale.

Please put removable label with your name, price, medium and title on back of your art piece.

ArTrove – Art not adhering to dimensions and/or regulations of "Miniature Art" will be rejected. All entry fees for rejected artwork is not refundable!

May submit up to 3 pieces.

Shipped entries must be in reusable boxes with return postage.

Sales & Commission: All sales will be conducted through Bella Art & Frame who will retain a 30% commission.

WHAT IS A MINIATURE? Miniature paintings and sculptures are fine art on a small scale, with minute attention to detail, which can withstand close inspection or enlargement. As a guideline for a general definition of small scale, a subject should be no larger than 1/6th actual size. (A human head is about 9 inches so the painted head should be no larger than 1.5 inches)

MINIATURE ART RULES:

- Image size not to exceed 25 square inches. Final size including framing not to exceed 7x9 inches. Sculptures not to exceed 8x8x8 inches including base.
- Subjects cannot exceed 1/6th of actual size.
- Frames must be of high quality, clean, and compliment the painting.

JOSEPH BOHLER

Joseph Bohler has been painting for more than 30 years. He has studied with such notables as Robert Lougheed and Richard Schmid. He is a life member of the Transparent Watercolor Society of America, a founding member of the Northwest Rendezvous, a signature member of the American Watercolor Society, the Watercolor USA Honor Society and the Rocky Mountain National Watermedia Society.

Bohler is featured in several books, including The Artistic Touch and The Artistic Touch II by Chris Unwins and Splash II and Splash IV by Rachel Rubin Wolf. He also is included in The Best of Flower Painting, The Best of Portrait Painting and Western Traditions: Contemporary Artists of the American West by Michael Duty.

He was commissioned by the late John Ritter and his brother, Tom, to paint a portrait of Tex Ritter, the famed actor, country singer and songwriter. The painting included Ritter's horse, White Flash, and was unveiled in March 1994 at the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum, during the Western Heritage Awards. He won the inaugural Donald Teague Memorial Award for works of art on paper at the 2013 Prix de West, and the Express Ranches Great American Cowboy Award for the best cowboy subject matter at the 2015 Prix de West.
